My name is Garrett Robinson. For the research analysis of project two, I plan to analyze the movie, *The Silence of the Lambs*, a movie in which a new FBI trainee, Clarice Starling, interrogates and speaks with the infamous, cannibalistic murderer, Hannibal Lecter, to try and solve the kidnapping of a young girl by Buffalo Bill. Hannibal Lecter is a former psychiatrist who developed Antisocial Personality Disorder, a condition coinciding with psychopathy and sociopathy.
